



Agricultural Meter Reimbursement Agreement

Requirements

To be eligible to participate in the North Plains Groundwater Conservation District (NPGCD) Meter Reimbursement Program and receive reimbursement from program funds, the following is required:

1. Annually, for the duration of the Meter Reimbursement Program, report to the NPGCD which crops were grown and the number of acres of each crop. The Program is expected to end 5 to 7 years after meter installation but is dependent upon which meter reimbursement contract the funds are disbursed under.
2. Annually, for the duration of the Meter Reimbursement Program, report to the NPGCD the totalizer readings for each meter. The normal groundwater production report reported to the District annually may or may not be sufficient to meet this requirement.
3. Install all meters in accordance with manufacturer's installation guidelines.
4. Maintain all meters in good condition and repair all meters in a timely manner to ensure that all groundwater pumped is recorded.
