North Plains Groundwater Conservation District invites you to participate in the annual "Water Conservation Art Contest". Fourth, fifth and sixth graders are invited to submit their best artwork related to water conservation for a competition. Thirteen winners will be included in the 2019 calendar produced by North Plains Groundwater Conservation District. Draw a picture of a way to conserve water, and be as creative as you like. Use lots of bright colors to make your artwork eye-catching! (Also please use 8.5" x 11" sheets, and turn your paper so that your picture is wider than it is tall.)

Guidelines are as follows:

- The more colorful the artwork, the better!
- Artwork drawn in pencil will be disqualified because it is difficult to see once scanned into a computer.
- The artwork requires landscape mode on 8.5" x 11" paper so that it is wider than it is tall. Artwork submitted vertically will be disqualified.
- Artwork should involve water conservation as its main topic.

Bring your picture and this form to North Plains Groundwater Conservation District at 603 East 1st Street in Dumas, TX, or mail your picture, unfolded in a large envelope, to North Plains Groundwater Conservation District, P.O. Box 795, Dumas, TX 79029. First place will be awarded a \$50.00 prize and the artwork will be featured on the cover of the calendar. There will be 12 second place winners who will receive \$25, and their drawing will be featured on one month of the calendar. Be sure to turn in this form, completely filled out, with your artwork. Deadline for turning in your artwork is June 15, 2018. Have fun doing your project and learning about water conservation!
